**EFFECTIVE MARCH 16, 2020**, **THIS COURT** hereby issues the following **ORDERS**, in acknowledgement and upon consideration of Executive Order 2020-01D (attached hereto as Exhibit A), issued March 9, 2020 by Hon. Mike DeWine, Governor of the State of Ohio and Declaring a State of Emergency as the result of Coronavirus Disease 2019 (COVID-19).

**IT IS HEREBY ORDERED** that the following proceedings that are currently scheduled for trial or any other hearing before the Probate Division are hereby continued for at least thirty (30) days, unless otherwise ordered, on a case-by-case basis:

- 1. Adoption Proceedings.
- 2. Change of Name Proceedings.
- 3. Non-emergency Guardianship Proceedings.
- 4. All other Miscellaneous Probate Proceedings.

**IT IS FURTHER ORDERED** that case-by-case exceptions to the continuances provided herein may be ordered at the discretion of the Court.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that upon filing, the following proceedings shall timely come before the Court pursuant to law:

- Adult Protective Services Proceedings.
- 2. Emergency Guardianship Proceedings.
  - Proceedings for a mentally ill person subject to court order.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that at the Court's discretion, hearings may be conducted telephonically, or by other means. This will be decided on a case-by-case basis. The Court will contact the parties in advance if a hearing is moved to telephone participation.

Upon consideration of the public health emergency created by COVID-19, the Court specifically **FINDS** good cause to continue the proceedings as stated herein.

The Union County Courthouse shall remain open to the public for court business only, which includes applications for marriage licenses. To protect the health of our

Probate and Juvenile Court staff will be available by telephone and email, mail will be received, and clerks' offices will remain open to receive filings.

The Court will vacate or amend this Order no later than April 10, 2020.
